announces a contest for the position of Scientific Adiunct – Department of Neurobiology  
at MAŁOPOLSKA CENTRE OF BIOTECHNOLOGY**

Eligible contestants must meet the requirements in art. 109, which was established in 27.07.2005 followed by the Law on Higher Education (Dz. U. nr 164, poz. 1365, z późn. zm.) and meet the following qualification criteria:

- 1) Possess a scientific degree,
- 2) High evaluation of the doctoral thesis,
- 3) Overall scientific achievements in addition to a dissertation and other leading positions,
- 4) Active participation in scientific life manifesting itself, in particular, in the speeches at conferences and symposiums,
- 5) An opinion from a department director or academic supervisor in regards to the qualifications and abilities of the candidate to research and teaching.

The ideal candidate should:

- 1) Have achievements in the field of research on the impact of circadian rhythms and sleep deprivation on brain function using advanced neuroimaging techniques (fMRI, EEG),
- 2) Have an excellent track record of scientific publications (list of min. 10 published works, indicating the papers published in journals from the list of JCR),
- 3) Have excellent written and oral communication skills in English,
- 4) Have diverse experience in international, interdisciplinary, and collaborative environment,
- 5) Have experience in the presentation of research results (the list of presentations at international conferences).
- 6) Have experience with grant/fellowship applications
- 7) Have experience in project management and supervision of junior researchers,

Candidate should submit the following documents (in English) to the Malopolska Centre of Biotechnology office, Cracow ul. Gronostajowa 7A, room 3/12 or electronically in the pdf format (max size: 50 MB) by email to [beata.binieda@uj.edu.pl](mailto:beata.binieda@uj.edu.pl).

In email title please include "**Scientific Adiunct – Department of Neurobiology**" and your first and last names in the email subject.

The applicant should submit as well:

- 1) Motivation letter and CV
- 2) A personal questionnaire,
- 3) A copy of a doctoral or habilitation degree,
- 4) A statement of research interests,
- 5) A form of the last periodic evaluation, if the candidate was assessed,
- 6) Opinion of the head of a research unit of the predispositions to research work, in the case of candidates without a PhD degree also provides information about the prospects of habilitation,
- 7) A statement that Jagiellonian University will be the primary workplace in the case of being hired,
- 8) A statement pursuant to art.109 item 1 of the Law of Higher Education,
- 9) A statement of consent to include a minimum staff for the creation / driving toward higher education, if you win the contest,
- 10) A statement of knowledge and acceptance of the rules on intellectual property and legal protection of intellectual property.

**The deadline for submitting applications is 30th March 2017. The outcome of the contest will take place on 20<sup>th</sup> April 2017.**

The application form also must include: *"I hereby authorize you to process my personal data included in my job application for the needs of the recruitment process" (in accordance with the Act of 29 August 1997 on the protection of personal data, Dz.U. z 2015, poz. 2135, as amended).*
