RECTOR of the Jagiellonian University announces a call for applications for a position of ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (in Polish terminology *ADIUNKT*) in the The Institute of the Study of Religions Faculty of Philosophy with an area of specialization in the history of religions of the ancient world or archaeology of ritual

Dean of the Faculty of Philosophy invites applications for permanent, full-time position at the rank of assistant professor. The successful applicant is expected to hold relevant Ph.D. and Habilitation in religious studies, Classics or a closely allied field at time of appointment.

The successful applicant is expected to have an innovative research portfolio in the history of religions in the Graeco-Roman world (please include one writing sample not to exceed 30 pages);

A specialization in (1) any of the religions in the Greaco-Roman World, (2) Archaeology of ritual in classical world, or (3) Historiography of ancient religions is desirable;

The successful applicant will be expected to advance the discipline by carrying out and publishing research in their area of specialization, to lecture and tutor students to a high academic standard in religious studies. The ability to teach ancient Greek Religion, Archaeology of Ritual or Materiality of Ancient Religion are essential. Fluency in English is required.

- 2) curriculum vitae,
- 3) personal survey,
- 4) a copy of doctoral or habilitation diploma; with a notarized translation, if from a university outside of Poland,
- 5) a letter of motivation that highlights the candidates most important research goals and achievements,
- 6) list of publications (including publisher and the number of pages),
- 7) list of courses taught,
- 8) a filled-out survey about research activities,
- 9) a filled-out survey about teaching activities, and if the candidate's teaching was reviewed, such reviews, along with any extant student surveys
- 10) review of doctoral dissertation or habilitation,
- 11) recommendation from chair/director or from a mentor/adviser,
- 12) proof of proficiency in one non-Polish language,
- 13) signed declaration that Jagiellonian University will be the primary place of employment, in case the candidate is selected for the position and decides to take up the position offered,
- 14) signed declaration of compliance with art. 109 ust. 1 of statute regarding Laws of higher education.

- 15) signed declaration of agreement to being counted as a member of the faculty minimum required by law to grant rights to award doctoral degrees and habilitations and/or for the purposes of creating courses of study, in case the candidate is selected and accepts the position offered.
- 16) signed declaration of being knowledgeable about and accepting of rules governing intellectual property and the legal protection awarded to intellectual property.

The deadline for submitting application is May 18th, 2017.

The decisions will be announced June 22nd, 2017.

The appointment will commence from 1 October 2017 and is open-ended
