in the research and faculty staff member group**

of the Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science  
**in academic discipline: Mathematics or Computer Science  
in the field of new mathematical models and tools**

The competitive selection process is open for all individuals, who meet the requirements set out in Articles 113 and 116.2.3) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science, and who meet the following eligibility criteria according to § 165 of the Statute of the Jagiellonian University:

- 1) holding at least a doctoral degree;
- 2) having relevant scientific achievements;
- 3) taking active part in scientific life;
- 4) having experience in teaching work.

Additionally:

- doctoral degree obtained not earlier than 7 years before 1.10.2020. The specified period of 7 years does not include periods of maternity leave, leave on the terms of maternity leave, paternity leave, parental leave or childcare leave, granted on the terms specified in the Act of June 26, 1974 - Labor Code, or periods of receiving an allowance maternity benefits or parental benefit, or periods of sickness benefit or rehabilitation benefit due to incapacity for work, including those caused by a disease requiring rehabilitation curative,
- the candidate's academic degree should be obtained outside of the Jagiellonian University or the candidate should be employed abroad at least since 2017.

1. application form;
2. resume which should contain: a list of publications, a list of awards and distinctions obtained, a list of internships and stays in research institutions, a list of completed and ongoing research projects (as a PI or contractor) with an indication of funding sources,
3. personal questionnaire filled in by the candidate;
4. copy of the doctoral diploma or a diploma confirming the candidate's habilitation degree, if applicable;
5. information on the candidate's scientific, teaching and organisational achievements;
6. information about any students courses;
7. reviews of a doctoral dissertation or habilitation thesis - if applicable;
8. latest performance evaluation form, if the candidate was subject of such evaluation;
9. opinion of the head of the department or academic tutor about the candidate's predispositions and qualifications for research and teaching - including the results of student surveys and evaluations, if the candidate was subject to such evaluation;

10. two letters of recommendation;
11. declaration of the candidate, confirming that the Jagiellonian University will be their primary place of work, in case of winning the selection process;
12. declaration under Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science;
13. declaration on acknowledging and accepting the rules and regulations concerning intellectual property management and commercialisation in force at the Jagiellonian University;
14. information regarding processing of personal data.

## Personal data processing information for job applicants

According to Article 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation – hereinafter GDPR), the Jagiellonian University informs that:

1. The Administrator of your personal data is the Jagiellonian University with its registered office in Gołębia 24, 31-007 Kraków, represented by the Rector of UJ.
2. The Jagiellonian University appointed the Data Protection Officer [www.iod.uj.edu.pl](http://www.iod.uj.edu.pl), Gołębia 24, 30-007 Kraków. The Officer can be contacted by email: [iod@uj.edu.pl](mailto:iod@uj.edu.pl) or at the telephone number 12 663 12 25.
3. Your personal data will be processed in order to:
  - a. conduct recruitment process for the position specified in this job advertisement – as part of the legal obligation of the Administrator pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit c of the GDPR in connection with the Polish Labour Code;
  - b. conduct recruitment process for the position specified in this job advertisement based on your consent pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit a of the GDPR – your consent is granted by the clear action of submitting your CV with the Administrator. The consent to the processing of personal data concerns data that you voluntarily provide as part of your CV, which do not result from Polish Labour Code.
4. The obligation to provide your personal data results from the law (it applies to personal data processed under Article 6 (1) lit c of the GDPR). Failure to provide you personal data will result in your inability to take part in the recruitment process. Submission of personal data processed on the basis of consent (Article 6 (1) lit a of the GDPR) is voluntary.
5. Your data will be processed during the recruitment period. In the event of not concluding the contract with you, your data will be deleted after the recruitment process.
6. You have the right of access to the content of your personal data, as well as the right to correct, delete, restrict processing, transfer, object to processing – on the terms and conditions set out in the GDPR.
7. If the processing is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw the consent at any time, which shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal. 8. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision making or profiling.
