of a UNIVERSITY PROFESSOR  
in the research and faculty staff member group  
of the Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science  
in academic discipline: Mathematics or Computer Science  
or Technical Informatics and Telecommunications  
in the thematic scope consistent with the research domains Anthropocene PRA: Earth System science (ESS)  
or Adaptation, Sustainability, Advancement, Protection (ASAP) or Emerging Fields (EF)

The competitive selection process is open for all individuals who meet the requirements set out in Articles 113 and 116.2.2) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science, and who meet the following eligibility criteria according to § 163 of the Statute of the Jagiellonian University:

- 1) Holding at least a doctoral degree;
- 2) Having significant and creative achievements in scientific, professional or artistic work;
- 3) Having achievements in organisational work;
- 4) Having achievements in teaching work.

Additional expectations:

- the degree should be obtained outside the Jagiellonian University or the candidate should be employed outside Poland at least since 2017
- achievements in scientific work should be confirmed by publications in reputable journals.

The position holder is expected to satisfy the following requirements (subject to evaluation after the specified time):

- publish articles in which JU is the only Polish affiliation in leading journals or at CORE-ranked conferences,
- submit at least one external Polish or international research grant of appropriate prestige, affiliated at JU,
- engage in interdisciplinary research with other members of the JU academic community,
- deliver 60 hours of innovative teaching per academic year, during for a period of 33 months.

The offered remuneration includes the base salary and the bonus.

The candidates, who would like to take part in the competitive selection process, should send the following documents to the email address [badania@matinf.uj.edu.pl](mailto:badania@matinf.uj.edu.pl):

1. letter of intent or interest,
2. resume which should contain: list of publications, list of obtained awards and distinctions, list of internships and stays in research institutions, list of completed and ongoing research projects (as a PI or contractor) with an indication of funding sources,

3. essay presenting the candidate's most important achievements,
4. the candidate's research plans with a clear reference to those research areas that occur in the Anthropocene PRA strategy,
5. personal questionnaire filled in by the candidate,
6. copy of the doctoral diploma or a diploma confirming the candidate's habilitation degree, if applicable;
7. information on the candidate's scientific, teaching and organisational achievements;
8. list of publications (with the publisher and the number of pages),
9. information concerning the academic courses taught by the candidate, if any;
10. doctoral dissertation or habilitation dissertation review, if applicable;
11. the last periodic evaluation form, if the candidate was subject to such evaluation,
12. declaration of the candidate, confirming that the Jagiellonian University will be their primary place of work, in case of winning the selection process;
13. declaration under Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science;
14. declaration on acknowledging and accepting the rules and regulations concerning intellectual property management and commercialisation in force at the Jagiellonian University;
15. information regarding processing of personal data.

Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an online interview.

## Personal data processing information for job applicants

According to Article 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation – hereinafter GDPR), the Jagiellonian University informs that:

1. The Administrator of your personal data is the Jagiellonian University with its registered office in Gołębia 24, 31-007 Kraków, represented by the Rector of UJ.
2. The Jagiellonian University appointed the Data Protection Officer [www.iod.uj.edu.pl](http://www.iod.uj.edu.pl), Gołębia 24, 30-007 Kraków. The Officer can be contacted by email: [iod@uj.edu.pl](mailto:iod@uj.edu.pl) or at the telephone number 12 663 12 25.
3. Your personal data will be processed in order to:
  - a. conduct recruitment process for the position specified in this job advertisement – as part of the legal obligation of the Administrator pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit c of the GDPR in connection with the Polish Labour Code;
  - b. conduct recruitment process for the position specified in this job advertisement based on your consent pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit a of the GDPR – your consent is granted by the clear action of submitting your CV with the Administrator. The consent to the processing of personal data concerns data that you voluntarily provide as part of your CV, which do not result from Polish Labour Code.
4. The obligation to provide your personal data results from the law (it applies to personal data processed under Article 6 (1) lit c of the GDPR). Failure to provide your personal data will result in your inability to take part in the recruitment process. Submission of personal data processed on the basis of consent (Article 6 (1) lit a of the GDPR) is voluntary.
5. Your data will be processed during the recruitment period. In the event of not concluding the contract with you, your data will be deleted after the recruitment process.
6. You have the right of access to the content of your personal data, as well as the right to correct, delete, restrict processing, transfer, object to processing – on the terms and conditions set out in the GDPR.
7. If the processing is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw the consent at any time, which shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal. 8. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision making or profiling.
