Jagiellonian University announces a competition

for the 3 posts of an ASSISTANT PROFESSOR

(POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCHER)

in the group of research staff

in the Dioscuri Center at the Faculty of Biochemistry, Biophysics and Biotechnology of the Jagiellonian University

In connection with the opening of the Dioscuri Center, a competition for three positions of assistant professor in the research staff group at the Department of Biochemistry, Biophysics and Biotechnology is announced. The research work concerns, "Molecular mechanisms of protein receptors - structural dynamics study by time-resolved X-ray crystallography" under the direction of Dr. Przemysław Nogły as part of the Dioscuri grant (<https://www.mpg.de/dioscuri>). Individuals hired for the above position will be tasked with supporting the head of the Dioscuri Center in conducting scientific research in the laboratory.

The competition is open to persons who meet the requirements set forth in Articles 113, 116(2)(3) of the Law of July 20, 2018. Law on Higher Education and Science and, in accordance with § 165 of the Statute of the Jagiellonian University, meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 1) have at least a doctoral degree;
- 2) have relevant scientific achievements;
- 3) take an active part in scientific life;

Additional requirements:

- 4) PhD degree in biological, chemical or physical sciences;
- 5) experience in preparing a manuscript;
- 6) experience in experimental work in biochemistry and/or structural biology and/or biophysics and/or analysis of large volumes of data;
- 7) fluency in English;

Candidates entering the competition should submit the following documents to the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Biochemistry, Biophysics and Biotechnology, Jagiellonian University, Krakow, 7 Gronostajowa Street, room D212, or by email to przemyslaw.nogly@uj.edu.pl:

1. application,
2. resume,
3. personal questionnaire for the applicant for employment,
4. a copy of the doctoral or postdoctoral diploma - if the candidate has one,
5. information on the scientific, teaching and organizational achievements of the candidate,
6. a list of publications (with the publisher and number of pages),
7. information on teaching activities, if any - this requirement does not apply to candidates for positions in the research staff group,
8. reviews of the doctoral thesis or dissertation - if the candidate has,
9. the form of the last periodic evaluation, if the candidate was subject to such an evaluation,
10. opinion of the head of the establishment or scientific supervisor on the candidate's predisposition and qualifications for scientific and teaching work - taking into account the results of student surveys, if the candidate was subject to such

evaluation,

11. a statement stating that UJ will be the primary place of work in case of winning the competition,
12. a statement pursuant to Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science,
13. a statement of knowledge and acceptance of the principles of intellectual property management and commercialization principles of UJ,
14. information on the processing of personal data.

The deadline for submitting applications is: 7.10.2022.

The closing date of the competition will be by 21.10.2022.

Personal data processing information for job applicants

According to Article 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation – hereinafter GDPR), the Jagiellonian University informs that:

1. The Administrator of your personal data is the Jagiellonian University with its registered office in Gołębia 24, 31-007 Kraków, represented by the Rector of UJ.
2. The Jagiellonian University appointed the Data Protection Officer www.iod.uj.edu.pl, Gołębia 24, 30-007 Kraków. The Officer can be contacted by email: iod@uj.edu.pl or at the telephone number 12 663 12 25.
3. Your personal data will be processed in order to:
 - a. conduct recruitment process for the position specified in the above advertisement – as part of the legal obligation of the Administrator pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit c of the GDPR in connection with the Polish Labour Code;
 - b. conduct recruitment process for the position specified in the above advertisement based on your consent pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit a of the GDPR – your consent is granted by the clear action of submitting your CV with the Administrator. The consent to the processing of personal data concerns data that you voluntarily provide as part of your CV, which do not result from Polish Labour Code.
4. The obligation to provide your personal data results from the law (it applies to personal data processed under Article 6 (1) lit c of the GDPR). Failure to provide your personal data will result in your inability to take part in the recruitment process. Submission of personal data processed on the basis of consent (Article 6 (1) lit a of the GDPR) is voluntary.
5. Your data will be processed during the recruitment period. In the event of not concluding the contract with you, your data will be deleted after the recruitment process.
6. You have the right of access to the content of your personal data, as well as the right to correct, delete, restrict processing, transfer, object to processing – on the terms and conditions set out in the GDPR.
7. If the processing is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw the consent at any time, which shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal. 8. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision making or profiling.
9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the Inspector General for the Protection of Personal Data, if you feel that the processing of your personal data violates the GDPR regulations.
