academic field biological sciences**

A new opportunity has arisen for a talented and skilled laboratory scientist to join the Malopolska Centre of Biotechnology (MCB). This is a position that subject to performance will become permanent within MCB. The staff scientist role supports a group leader to run the science of the laboratory, provide training to new staff such as PhD students and post-docs and provide the continued know-how within the group. Furthermore, the successful applicant will also be expected to carry out research that supports the group objectives. This is a position that is most suitable for candidates who are excellent scientists, enjoy working in the laboratory but who are not planning becoming independent scientists in the short or medium term. A staff scientist frequently acts as an intermediary between the group leader and other staff when difficult situations arise. MCB is an international institute and the working language is English. For excellent candidates who do not have some of the required technical skills, mandatory training will be required which may have to be taken overseas.

The competitive selection process is open for all individuals, who meet the requirements set out in Articles 113 and 116.2.3) of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science, and who meet the following eligibility criteria according to § 165 of the Statute of the Jagiellonian University:

Basic requirements

- 1) Holding a doctoral degree of education within the life sciences sphere.
- 2) Having relevant scientific achievements.
- 3) Taking active part in scientific life.

Additional requirements

- 1) Excellent skills in tissue culture and ability to work with the infectious material.
- 2) Expertise in molecular and cell biology work.
- 3) Excellent team work and interpersonal skills and ability to see all sides of the picture.
- 4) Can do attitude and ability to seek solutions to problems.
- 5) Excellent Polish and English spoken and written skills.
- 6) Experience of training others in experimental and other general scientific skills
- 7) Strong organizational and time management skills.

Desirable Skills

- 1) Experience in working with class 3 or 3+ infectious material within the BSL3/BSL3+ laboratory.
- 2) Experience in virology.
- 3) Laboratory animal experience.

6. list of publications (along with the respective publishing houses and the number of pages);
7. information concerning educational activities carried out by the candidate, if any;
– this requirement does not apply to candidates for positions in the the research staff member group.
8. doctoral dissertation or habilitation dissertation review, if applicable;
9. latest performance evaluation form, if the candidate was subject to such evaluation;
10. recommendation concerning the candidate's research and teaching work, issued by the director of the organisational unit or a scientific supervisor, including the results of student surveys and evaluations, if the candidate was subject to such evaluation;
11. declaration of the candidate, confirming that the Jagiellonian University will be their primary place of work, should they be selected in the competitive selection process;
12. declaration under Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science;
13. declaration on acknowledging and accepting the rules and regulations concerning intellectual property management and commercialisation in force at the Jagiellonian University;
14. information regarding processing of personal data;

Personal data processing information for job applicants

According to Article 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation – hereinafter GDPR), the Jagiellonian University informs that:

1. The Administrator of your personal data is the Jagiellonian University with its registered office in Gołębia 24, 31-007 Kraków, represented by the Rector of UJ.
2. The Jagiellonian University appointed the Data Protection Officer www.iod.uj.edu.pl, Gołębia 24, 30-007 Kraków. The Officer can be contacted by email: iod@uj.edu.pl or at the telephone number 12 663 12 25.
3. Your personal data will be processed in order to:
 - a. conduct recruitment process for the position specified in the above advertisement – as part of the legal obligation of the Administrator pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit c of the GDPR in connection with the Polish Labour Code;
 - b. conduct recruitment process for the position specified in the above advertisement based on your consent pursuant to Art. 6 (1) lit a of the GDPR – your consent is granted by the clear action of submitting your CV with the Administrator. The consent to the processing of personal data concerns data that you voluntarily provide as part of your CV, which **do not** result from Polish Labour Code.
4. The obligation to provide your personal data results from the law (it applies to personal data processed under Article 6 (1) lit c of the GDPR). Failure to provide your personal data will result in your inability to take part in the recruitment process. Submission of personal data processed on the basis of consent (Article 6 (1) lit a of the GDPR) is voluntary.
5. Your data will be processed during the recruitment period. In the event of not concluding the contract with you, your data will be deleted after the recruitment process.
6. You have the right of access to the content of your personal data, as well as the right to correct, delete, restrict processing, transfer, object to processing – on the terms and conditions set out in the GDPR.
7. If the processing is based on consent, you have the right to withdraw the consent at any time, which shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal.
